To provide Speech Therapy services which reflect the philosophy and standards of Positively Kids, and ensure Early Intervention guidelines are followed in compliance with State and Federal rules. This **Full-Time** position will work direct services as well as, under the direction of the Vice President of Early Intervention, Supervisor and collaborate with other specialists and programs under Positively Kids.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Provides evaluations and ongoing assessments as a member of a multi-disciplinary team and provides trainings for staff and/or families;
- Provides speech therapy services to infants/toddlers ages 0-3 who have language or feeding delays requiring in home therapy or natural environment services;
- Demonstrate knowledge of normal and abnormal communication development; speech therapy intervention techniques; identification, evaluation and diagnosis of communication disorders;
- Use and care of assistive devices used in speech and language therapy;
- Responsible for completion of timely documentation including progress notes, reports, and Medicaid authorizations;
- Communicate effectively with families, members of the Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) team, and other health care providers regarding diagnosis and therapy.
- Maintain punctual and dependable scheduled visits and communication with IFSP team;
- Participates in the development of the IFSP and makes recommendations/treatment plans for the overall care plan for the family;
